End of 2023 update

A belated, Happy New Year, to you and your families

2023 was a successful, busy and productive year for the CUFC Lottery, building on a good relationship with the very supportive and appreciative CUFC CEO, Alex Tunbridge.

Membership

We ended 2023 with 512 members, an increase of 122 on the previous year (2022), an impressive 31% increase, so, thank you all, for your support, it really does mean a lot to ourselves (the committee), the club and beneficiaries.

At the time of writing (28/01/2024), membership is currently 521.

Draws

Due to the membership increase, there are now 4x £100 weekly Must Win Monday (MWM) winners, resulting in a fantastic 1:130 chance of winning.

The 2023/4 introduced Midweek Money Can't Buy (MMCB) Match Ball Presentation prize has been a huge success, with all winners enjoying the experience.

The prize means that during the football season, we now have weekly draws every Monday, Wednesday and Friday, representing 6 fantastic weekly opportunities for our members to get something back and rewarded for their support.

We celebrated 3x Abbey Accumulator (AA) winners:

Steve Childerley won the Jackpot (£2,500) on 6th October

David York won £850 on 1st December

Jamie Smith won £500 on 8th December

We also celebrated the club's milestone 1,000th home and 2,000th football league fixture, announcing 6x £500 winners on 19th August v Bristol Rovers.

A total of £13,900 was won by you, our members, in the weekly MWM draws

Total value of prize money won by you, our members, totalled £20,750 (MWM, AA and 'milestone' draws)
