Registration

CUFC Lottery registered & licensed as a Small Society Lottery, with Cambridge City Council:

- Registration Number CAMLOT 000019
- Renewed annually (£20 license fee)
- Run under rules laid down by Gambling Act 2005
- Monthly returns submitted
- Underpinning Small Society is Cambridge Fans United, a registered Industrial Provident Society, No 29118R
 - CUFC Lottery is an independent, self funding organisation, with it's own Committee, Bank & PayPal accounts, run on behalf of Cambridge United Football Club

Developments

Increased CUFC social media promotion of CUFC Lottery & winners

CUFC supply all **MMCB** prizes

Membership numbers remain steady, despite economic climate

Once membership exceeds 610 members = 5th **MWM** winner (5x £100 winners) will be introduced, maintaining great winning odds

- Each additional 100 members = An extra **MWM** winner
